Connecting the Community

The Treeby Community Association (TCA) was incorporated in November 2017 with the help of Stockland and the City of Cockburn and with the aim of representing and connecting our community. Membership consists of residents in the suburb of Treeby. We aim to provide opportunities for locals to make new connections, come together and create a sense of ownership, pride and belonging within Treeby. We aim to build a strong community through three main programs:

- Calleya Community Garden (management and operation);
- Community Connections (social events and community building);
- Community Safety (Neighbourhood Watch program and events)

Membership is \$10 per year and provides access to the community garden and rights to attend and vote in general meetings and the AGM.



General Meetings are open to all Treeby residents. They are held at the Atwell Community Centre at 7pm on the second Wednesday of the months of February, April, June, August, and December. The Annual General Meeting is held in October each year.

Stockland is building a community garden on Clementine Boulevard. TCA has a Licence to manage the garden. Send us an email or attend a General Meeting if you are interested in being involved with the garden.

Keep up to date with what's happening in your community

TCA aims to keep Treeby residents up to date with what is happening within the Calleya Estate via general and special meetings and our Facebook page.

General Meetings include updates on infrastructure, road upgrades, and upcoming events. The General Meeting is also a forum where residents can raise concerns they have or ask questions. Special guests are invited to provide information to residents and hear their ideas and concerns.

Guests have included the managers of the new Nido Early School, the Member for Jandakot, the Deputy Mayor of the City of Cockburn, and East Ward Councillors. The Directors of Engineering, Planning and Waste Services from City of Cockburn have also attended. Stockland staff attend each General Meeting.

What's On in Treeby

TCA holds or takes part in community events in Treeby including community BBQs for residents to meet their neighbours, Neighbourhood Watch community safety events, and Halloween and Christmas celebrations.

What has TCA achieved so far?

TCA already has an impressive list of achievements including:



TCA has been awarded over \$8,000 in grants from Stockland, the City of Cockburn and the Federal Government.

 Negotiated with Main Roads to ensure full access, including traffic lights will be maintained at Ghostgum Avenue following the Armadale Road upgrade.

- Construction of a temporary dual-purpose path/cycle way from Ghostgum to Tapper.
- Input into the design of the new Treeby sports & recreation centre.
- Erection of a direction sign on the Jandakot Road, Berrigan Drive, Pilatus Street intersection to show correct turning lanes and improve safety.
- Established the Buy Nothing Treeby Facebook page.

In July 2019 Treeby residents, Police and Co-Safe all pulled together and caught intruders who had been damaging Treeby bushland in four-wheel drive vehicles. A meeting on 24 July was attended by residents, Police, Co-Safe, City of Cockburn staff and councillors, Stockland and some of the 4-wheel drivers. It was made clear that damage to our Estate is unacceptable. Following the meeting Deputy Mayor Lee-Anne Smith put the following motion to council: "That council set up a reference group to investigate suitable land within the City for off road motor vehicle / motor cycle use."
